Yukon Water Board launches new logo

The Yukon Water Board has updated its logo to better reflect its role as the sole regulator of the use of water and deposit of waste into water in the Yukon.

The previous logo served the Board for many years. This update provides a clear, modern visual identity that is representative of its ongoing approach to sustainable water management.

The logo update does not signal a change in the Board's legal mandate, responsibilities, or decision-making processes. The Yukon Water Board continues to ensure responsible water governance through its commitment to transparent, accessible, and fair processes.

Logo imagery

Water is at the core of the Yukon Water Board's mandate. The logo's design draws inspiration from Yukon's rivers, lakes, and watersheds. The design also reflects the close and enduring connection between water and land, and the influence that each has on the other.

Use of the new logo

The updated logo will be phased in to Yukon Water Board materials including Board and Secretariat communications, applications, licenses, approval documents, and digital platforms such as the Board's website and online public register, Waterline.

During the transition to the new logo, materials that display either the new or old logo continue to be authoritative when issued by the Board or Secretariat.
