## Digitization of the Public Register

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To further reduce paper use in the licensing process, the Yukon Water Board is transitioning the public register to a fully digital format. All records received after April 1, 2026 will be stored digitally. Digital submissions in the licensing and approvals processes are strongly encouraged.

### Context

In alignment with its [directive on printed deliverables](#), the Board continues to promote the reduction of paper use in the water licensing and Class 4 placer land use approval processes. Applications, interventions, claims, and post-licensing deliverables may all be submitted electronically. These records will be stored in a digital format.

Under the Board's 2021 Rules of Procedure, paper copies will still be accepted and provided upon request; any paper records will be scanned and stored digitally.

The public register will remain accessible online through [Waterline](#), and in person at the Yukon Water Board offices.
